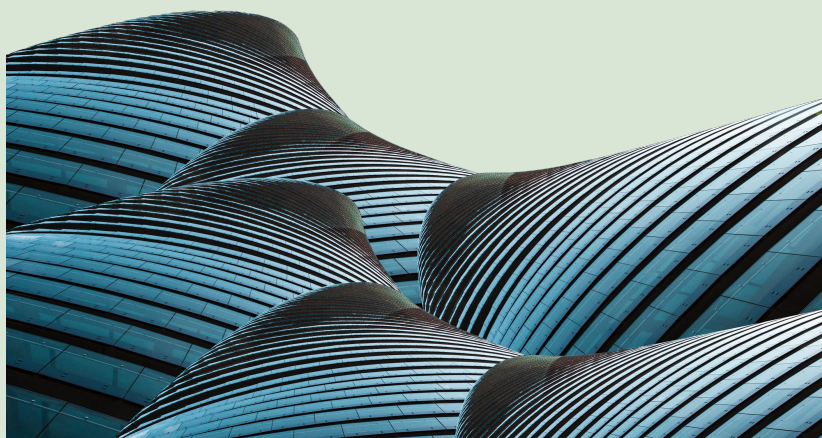


# HEDROC TRAINING WORKSHOPS

## Aims

- Explore how these issues are manifested, and the impact it is having on the organisation.
- Discuss what policies and strategies the organisation has in place to manage discourse and practice around conflict, and review how they are working.
- Provide participants with recommended guidelines on how employers can support employees affected by conflict.
- Review examples where there have been signs of disagreement among staff and where appropriate role play conflict management.
- Explore and prioritise further strategies that can be actioned by the organisation to optimise a healthy working environment.
